

Engine Mount Kit with High Performance Silicone Bushings 01-10 GM 6.6L Duramax



Installation Guide









CONTENTS:

- A (6) M10 x 1.50 MM x 35 MM flanged hex head screw
- **B** (8) M10 x 1.50 MM x 20 MM flanged hex head screw
- C (2) Engine Mounts

Customize your ride:

Change just your PPE Bushings if you want the feedback from your engine to be softer or firmer.

PPE Engine Mount Kit Bushings are available in four different hardness (durometer) options. 50A is closest to OEM firmness.

PREPARATION:

Use lift or jack stands for greater access.

Vehicle off. Engine cool. Vehicle secure.

- Step 1. Remove both front wheels and wheel well covers.
- Step 2. Remove upper fan shroud.
- Step 3. Disconnect passenger side (cold side) intercooler boost tube (LBZ/LMM only).
- Step 4. Loosen the two nuts fastening the transmission mount to the crossmember.
- Step 5. Driver side: Remove the three 15mm bolts securing the engine mount to the chassis.
- Step 6. Lift engine just enough to clear factory engine mount over bracket.
- Step 7. Remove four 15mm bolts that secure factory mount to engine block.
- Step 8. Remove factory engine mount.

INSTALLATION:

- Step 9. Remove lower bushing through-bolt on the PPE Engine Mount to allow install and tightening of each of the lower engine block bolts.
- Step 10. Tighten the four engine block bolts to 43 ft lbs.
- Step 11. Reinsert the lower through-bolt. Finger tight for now.
- Step 12. Lower driver side engine to align the Engine Mount to the frame. Insert frame bolts (thread lock recommended). Torque to 48 ft lbs.
- Step 13. Tighten the through-bolts snug. Don't crush the silicone bushing.

Repeat Steps 5-12 for passenger side.

Reassemble removed parts. Remember to tighten transmission mount bolts.

Installation complete.
