
Follow (Fig 1-5) to remove bumper from vehicle and remove wiring harness from bumper.




WARNING! Do not remove bumper bolts unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or it may fall.













Follow (Fig 13 – 15) to attach HD4 Rear Bumper to vehicle mounting point. Ensure Bumper is level before tightening hardware.









WARNING! Do not crawl under bumper unless it is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.
