












(Fig 1) Start at Driver Side rear bumper. Remove (2) Nuts attached to Bumper. Remove (1) Nut attached the Frame and (1) Bumper Support Bolt to remove Bumper Support Bar. Hardware will be reused later.

Follow (Fig 1 - 8) to attach the assembly to Rear Driver Side Bumper.


(Fig 2) Attach Main Bracket to Bumper Studs, and refasten the **Bumper Nuts to top Bumper Stud** only.



(Fig 3) Attached Main Bracket




(Fig 5) Attach Support Bracket to Main Bracket using indicated hardware.



(Fig 4) Attach Support Bracket to Bottom Bumper Stud over Main Bracket, and the Frame Stud. Reuse Frame Nut to fasten top section. Do not tighten at this time.


(2) 8mm Combo Bolts



(Fig 6) Attach base arm to Main Bracket using indicated hardware

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
(Fig 7) Attach Bumper Support Bracket to Main Bracket using indicated hardware




(Fig 8) Attached Base Arm and Bumper Support Bracket

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Follow (Fig 9 - 10) to install Step Pad onto Assembly Base. Installation is complete. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight. **Note:** Excess dirt and debris may prevent the step from functioning properly. Simply clean the dirt off with water to maintain optimal condition of Corner Step.



(Fig 9) Slide (2) T-Bolts into each Step Pad channel



(Fig 10) Attach Step Pad onto Base Arm using indicated hardware
