





PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Preassemble the Mounting Brackets (Items 3-5). Do not tighten at this time. See Figure 2.




3. Locate the 3 mounting locations on the rocker panel and insert the square plastic retainers (Item 19). See Figure 3



- 4. At the rear mounting locations, loosely install Mounting Bracket 'A' with preassembled Mounting Bracket 'C' (Item 7) using the supplied M8 hardware (Items 10-12). See **Figures 4 & 5**.
- 5. At the center mounting locations, loosely install Middle Mount Bracket (Item 5) with preassembled Mounting Bracket 'C' (Item 7) using the supplied M8 hardware (Items 10-12). See **Figure 4 & 5.**
- 6. At the front passenger mounting location, loosely install Mounting Bracket 'A' (Item 3) with preassembled Mounting bracket 'C' (Item 7).

Note: Installation is similar to Rear Mounting Bracket







7. At the front driver mounting location, loosely install Mounting Bracket 'B' (Item 4) with preassembled Mounting bracket 'C' (Item 7) using M8 hardware (Items 10-12) See **Figure 4 & 5**


Note: Installation is similar to Rear Mounting Bracket

- 8. Attach 4 large bracket covers (Item 9) on the front and rear brackets using the M6 hex head cap screws (Items 14-16). See **Figure 6.**
- 9. Attach 2 small bracket covers (Item 8) on the center mounting brackets using the M6 hex head cap screws (Items 14-16). See **Figure 6.**



- 10. Insert the plate adapters (Item 6) into board assemblies (Item 1 & 2) by first putting them in parallel to the board, then turning them 90 degrees to be perpendicular to the board. (Make sure the plate hooks onto the bottom of the board, and the screws are facing outwards. See **Figure 7.**
- 11. Mount the step board assemblies (Item 1 &2) to the previously installed brackets using the M8 hardware (Items 16-18) See **Figure 8.**
- 12. Align step bar and brackets to desired positioning then torque and tighten all: M10 to 35ft-lbs, M8 hardware to 20ft-lbs, and M6 hardware to 8.5 ft-lbs.




