

1. Inspect and verify that all components needed to install the brake caliper covers are accounted for prior to installation.

Lift the vehicle and remove the wheels to access the brake calipers. If using a jack, you must use jack stands.

Do not rely on the jack to support the vehicle. If the jack fails, serious in-jury or death may occur.


Align the front caliper cover base mounting brackets over the front calipers, hooking the upper mounting tabs into the slots in the top of the calipers.




3. Push the face of the front caliper cover base mounting brackets down until the pre-installed cage nuts fit over the face of the calipers. IMPORTANT: On some models, you may need to pull the bracket from the bottom to keep the cage nuts from catching on the face of the caliper.




4. Align the front caliper cover spacer bracket tabs into the slots in the base mounting brackets installed in the previous step. Push in on the front caliper cover spacer brackets until the mounting tabs make contact with the face of the factory calipers.



5. Align the front caliper covers over the mounting brackets and install the supplied flat washers, lock washers and 1/4-20 x 3/4" allen head bolts into the preinstalled 1/4-20 cage nuts in the base mounting brackets.




6. Make sure the caliper covers are properly aligned and tighten the mounting hardware to finish the front caliper cover installation.




7. Begin the rear caliper cover installation by first installing the outer

supplied hardware. Install the supplied flat washers and lock washers onto the supplied 1/4-20 x 3/4"allen head bolts, pass the bolts through the outer holes in the caliper covers and install flat washers, lock washers and 1/4-20 hex nuts. Tighten until the hardware is secure.




8. To align the rear calipermounting brackets, rotate the center mounting tab on the mounting brackets underneath the factory calipercarrier brackets. Pry out on the sides of the bracket as you press in on the center to help hook the mounting tab around the calipercarrier brackets.



9. Press the center mounting tab tightly against the back of the factory caliper carrier brackets.



10. Align the rear caliper covers over the mounting brackets and install the supplied flat washers, lock washers and 1/4-20 x3/4" allen head bolts into the pre-installed 1/4-20 cage nuts on the mounting brackets.



11. Make sure the calipers covers are properly aligned and tighten the mountinghardware to finish the rear caliper cover installation. Reinstall the wheels, torque the lug nuts to manufacturer's specifications and lower the vehicle to finish.
