## **PROCEDURE:**

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING THE INSTALLATION. DRILLING AND SPECIAL TOOLS MAY BE REQUIRED. ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED. ON MODELS WITH DEF TANK, SELECT A FLAT, LEVEL AREA FOR INSTALLATION. CUTTING MAY BE REQUIRED.

- Start the installation under the driver side of the vehicle. EXT/ Double Cab: Locate the 4 tabs along the bottom edge of the body, (pinch weld). Mounting Brackets will bolt to the 1st, 2nd and 4th mounting tabs, (Figure 1). Crew Cab: Locate the 5 tabs along the bottom edge of the body, (pinch weld). Mounting Brackets will bolt to the 1st, 3rd, (just in front of center of cab), and 5th mounting tabs, (Figure 1). Directly above each tab is a top mounting location on the side of the body panel. Hold a Bracket up in place to help determine the mounting holes to use along the body.
- 2. Determine the correct procedure for your model year and each Bracket location.

Bottom mounting location on the edge of the pinch weld.

## Flat tab on pinch weld with factory installed weld nut:

Thread hex bolt into weld nut from the backside-down to clear paint from threads, (Figure 2). Flat tab on pinch weld with hole:

Select (1) 8mm Clip Nut. Slide the Clip Nut over the tab with the nut facing up behind the tab, (Figures 3—5). Line up threaded nut with hole in the tab. Repeat for each mounting location. Locate top mounting location on the back side of the body panel.

## Models with factory installed threaded insert in body panel:

Thread 8mm Hex Bolt into threaded insert to clear paint as required, (Figures 2 & 3). Large and small hole in side of body panel:

Remove the rubber plug from the larger hole, (Figure 4). Select (1) 8mm Clip Nut. Slide the Clip Nut into the larger hole. Line up the threaded nut with the smaller hole, (Figure 5).

- Select (1) Mounting Bracket. NOTE: (5) Brackets are universal and will fit all (3) left side locations and the center and rear right side locations only. Bolt the Mounting Bracket to the Clip Nuts and/or the factory threaded holes with (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Figures 6 & 7). Snug but do not fully tighten the hardware.
- 4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to install the (2) remaining driver side Brackets,
  - a. On models without factory mounting holes in tab or body panel for rear Bracket, see "Special Instructions" below. Otherwise continue on to Step 5

# SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS for 01-06, 07 "Classic" Crew Cab models without factory holes in body panel and/or pinch weld tab only—drilling is required: IMPORTANT! Any cutting or drilling tool may break or

shatter. Government regulations require safety glasses & equipment at all times when cutting or drilling. Once the front and center Brackets have been installed, temporarily set the passenger side Running

Board on top of the (2) Brackets.

- a) Attach the Running Board to the front and center Brackets but do not fully tighten the hardware, (Figures 12—14). Level and align the Running Board to the side of the vehicle. Use a stand to support the Running Board if necessary.
- b) Hold the rear Bracket up in position against the bottom of the blank tab, (no hole), on the pinch weld and against the inner body panel. NOTE: Use a clamp to temporarily hold the Bracket in position, (Figure 8). With the Bracket level to the Running Board and tight against the body panel, mark the Bracket location onto the tab and body panel, (Figure 8A). Remove the Bracket and Running Board.
- c) Drill a 3/8" to 7/16" hole through the tab on the pinch weld, (Figure 8B). Slide an 8mm Clip Nut over the tab, (Figure 3),
- d) Attach (1) Bracket to the tab and Clip Nut on pinch weld only with (1) 8mm Hex Bolt, (1) 8mm Lock Washer and (1) 8mm Flat Washer.

## OPTIONAL BUT RECOMMENDED for 01-06, 07 "Classic" Crew Cab models only:

Drill a 7/16" hole (if no factory hole exists) in the inner body panel at the marked location for the top of the Mounting Bracket, **(Figure 8A & 8B)**. **IMPORTANT**: Due to limited clearance between the inner body panel and the frame, a 90-degree drill adapter is required. A special "short" drill bit may also be necessary.

Assemble the metal Insert Tool as pictured in **Figure 9**. Push the Insert and Tool assembly into the drilled hole. **NOTE:** If Insert fits too tight, tap it into place with a small hammer.

Firmly hold the handle on the Tool and tighten the Hex Bolt in the Insert until it is fully locked in place, (Figure 10A & B). NOTE: Do not over tighten the Insert or a pull out may occur. Once the Insert is fully compressed, remove the Hex Bolt and Tool from the Insert. Repeat Step 3, (Figure 11), to bolt a Bracket in the rear location.

Repeat this step to install the Insert for the passenger side rear Mounting Bracket, once the front & center brackets have been installed (Figure 13). Continue to Step 5.

- 5. Once all (3) Brackets have been fully installed, select the driver side Running Board. **NOTE**: Angled end of Running Board is the front, **(see Page 1)**. Locate the two channels in the bottom of the Running Board. (3) 6mm T-Bolts are required for each channel. Slide T-Bolts into each channel, **(Figure 12)**.
- 6. Hold the Running Board up in approximate position and slide the T-Bolts along the channel to line up with the (3) Mounting Brackets. Tilt the Board up at a slight angle and push back against the vehicle until the T-Bolts fit into the slots in the Brackets.
- 7. Secure the Running Board to the Brackets with (6) 6mm Flat Washers, (6) 6mm Lock Washers and (6) 6mm Hex Nuts, (Figures 13 & 14). Do not tighten hardware at this time. NOTE: The Running Board is

designed to fit close to the vehicle. It may be necessary to loosen the Bracket hardware and tilt the Brackets downward to insert the Running Board between the Brackets and the body.

- 8. Level and adjust the Running Board and tighten all hardware.
- Move to the passenger side of the vehicle. On the passenger side, determine if the vehicle is equipped with a plastic diesel exhaust fluid (DEF) tank, (Figures 15 & 16).
  Models without DEF tank, skip to Step 10.

**Models with DEF tank**: The tank sits close to the side of the body. With specialized tools, the passenger front upper and lower Bracket can be installed but room is limited. It may be easier to drop the tank down to access the inner side of the body panel for upper bracket installation. Tank will not need to be removed, only dropped down for access to mounting location. **IMPORTANT**: If tank is full, it will be very heavy and assistance is highly recommended to avoid injury or damage to the vehicle or the tank. It is recommended that installation is performed when the DEF tank is low on fluid before dropping the tank.

- a. On models with plastic lower tray under the tank, remove the (3) hex bolts attaching the tray to the frame, (Figure 15), and remove the tray. 2017 2500/3500 models: Remove the (4) hex bolts attaching plastic cover to DEF tank, (Figure 16A) and remove plastic cover, (Figure 16B).
- **b.** Release the tank filler hose. Release the plug for the sending unit on the top of the tank.
- **c.** Support the tank with a floor jack. Place a smooth flat surface, (wooden block for example), between the floor jack and the tank to avoid damaging the plastic tank. Do not push up on the tank; only support the weight of the tank with the jack.
- d. Remove the (2) bolts securing the tank straps to the vehicle, (Figure 17). Tilt the straps to release from the brackets. Slowly lower the tank until the top of the tank is almost visible. Use blocks or stands to support the tank while installing the front Upper and Lower Brackets.
  e. Broceed to Step 10.
- e. Proceed to Step 10.
- Locate the first tab on the edge of the pinch weld, (Figures 1—2, 19 & 21). Select the Upper Bracket, (Figure 18). Repeat Steps 2 & 3 to attach the passenger front Upper Bracket to the side of the body panel, (Figure 19). Do not tighten hardware at this time.
- **11.** Line up the hole in the bottom of the Upper Bracket with the hole in the tab on the pinch weld.
  - a. Models with a weld-nut: Slide the Bracket over the weld-nut, (Figure 19). Attach the Lower Bracket to the bottom of the body and weld-nut with (1) 8mm x 25mm Hex Bolt, (1) 8mm Lock Washer and (1) 8mm Flat Washer, (Figures 25 & 27). Leave loose at this time.
  - b. Models with flat tab and hole: Insert the 8mm Bolt Plate down through the hole in the Upper Bracket and mounting tab, (Figures 20 & 26). Attach the Lower Bracket to the bottom of the body and Bolt Plate with (1) 8mm Flat Washer and (1) 8mm Nylon Lock Nut, (Figures 25 & 26). Leave loose at this time.
- 12. Line up the side tab on the Lower Bracket with the threaded hole in the side of the Upper Bracket. Attach the Lower Bracket to the Upper Bracket with (1) 8mm x 25mm Hex Bolt, (1) 8mm Lock Washer and (1) 8mm Flat Washer, (Figures 27). Leave loose at this time.
- **13.** Repeat **Steps 1—3** for the (2) remaining passenger side Bracket installations. **NOTE**: Cradles on Brackets installed on passenger side will face forward.
  - a. 2017 2500/3500 DEF tank models: Locate the 2nd tab bracket location along the bottom edge of the body, (pinch weld), (Figure 22). Hold the DEF cover in place and mark the 2nd Bracket location onto the cover, (Figure 23). Use a sharp knife or hacksaw blade to carefully cut a slot in the plastic cover to clear the 2nd Bracket, (Figure 24). Remove as little plastic as possible.
- **14.** Repeat **Steps 5—8** to install the passenger side Running Board.
- 15. Once the Running Board has been installed and all hardware fully tightened, reinstall the DEF tank and cover, if equipped, as described in **Steps 9 & 13**.
- **16.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

**To protect your investment**, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. **For stainless steel**: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Board.

For gloss black finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Running Board.
