PROCEDURE

 Remove contents from box, verify that all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Locate the mounting location on the rocker panel. Remove the rubber plugs covering the threaded holes.
- 3. Locate the mounting brackets (Item 3) and loosely secure it to the rocker using the provided M8 Hex head hardware (sems) (Items 9-11) See Figure 1.

Note: If threaded holes are not on the truck's rocker panel, remove the rubber plugs located on the rocker panel at each mounting location and insert nut clips.)



4. Attach the (6) bracket covers (Item 5) onto all the mounting brackets using the M6 hex head cap crews (Items 6-8) See Figure 2.

Insert the plate adapters (Items 4) into board assemblies (Item 1 &2) by first putting them in parallel to the board, then turning them 90 degrees to be perpendicular to the board. (Make sure the plate hooks onto the bottom of the bracket, and the screws are facing outwards. See **Figure 3**.

Note: Put 2 adapter plates in the front side and 1 in the back.

6. Install the running board onto the previously installed brackets using the supplied M8 hardware (Item 12-14). See Figure 4

Note: Make sure the plate adapters align with the brackets to attach the board to the mounting brackets.)

7. Align step bar and brackets to desired positioning then torque and tighten all: M8 hardware to 20ft-lbs and M6 hardware to 7.4 ft-lbs.
