



Tools needed phillips head screwdriver.



Open tailgate and remove the phillips head screws located inside the tail gate area.



Once the screws are removed, you will be able to pull tail lens straight out.



Remove the 4 bulbs socket from the stock lens. Remove the three bulbs leaving the side marker light installed.



Plug the pigtails into the stock wire harness.

Make sure the green wire match the green and black to black

Reinstall the taillight back on to the vehicle. Make sure all functions are working properly before driving.



Tools Needed:
Phillips Screw Driver

Step 1: Lower the tail gate
exposing the two screws.

Step 2; Remove the upper and
lower screws



Step 3: Remove the taillight
by pulling straight out.

Step 4: Remove all 3 sockets
from the taillight housing.

Step 5: Remove the bulbs
from the two black sockets.



Step 6: Place the resistor in
a safe location in the housing.

Step 7: Connect the pigtails
to the stock sockets.



Make sure the wires match:
Black to Black



Step 8: Connect the resistor
to the taillight housing.



Step 9: Place the LED taillight
into the truck housing, secure
with screws.



Make sure all functions are
working properly before
driving.
