



Before you begin installation, read all instructions thoroughly.

Proper tools will improve the quality of installation and reduce the time required.

Periodic inspection of your product should be performed to ensure all hardware and / or components remain secure.

These running steps are engineered and manufactured specifically for driver and passenger sides of your vehicle. The short, 45° bend and the largest step (18") is installed towards the front of the vehicle. For straight cut bed access step models, the striaght cut is installed to the rear of the vehicle.

To help prevent damage to the product or vehicle, refer to the specified torque specifications when securing hardware during the installation process.


Maintenance

Mild automotive detergent may be used to clean the product. Do not use dish detergent, abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, wire brushes or other similar products that may damage the finish.

Step 1


Starting on the driver side, locate the holes for the upper mounts (x3) and install the supploed M8 clips in each position.

Note: There will be four attachment points for the quad cab and five for the crew cab. Only three will be used for the installation.



Step 2

Install the step, aligning the brackets to the upper clips using an M8 bolt, lock washer and flat washer for the upper attachment. Use an M8 bolt, flat washer and M8 nut for the lower attachment. Leave the hardware loose at this time



Step 3

After final adjustment, tighten all hardware to 17-20 ft-lbs. of torque.

Step 4

Repeat steps 1 through 3 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
