1. Before beginning the installation, please read all directions carefully and verify that all necessary hardware is accounted for. If any parts are missing, stop the installation and contact your distributor immediately.

2. To maintain and care this product keep it clean and do not use abrasive cleaners or polish waxes. We recommend to use only non-abrasive automotive wax such as pure carnauba to avoid scratches and rust.

3. Once the main brackets are installed (sold separately), the approximate installation time is 15 min.

4. Place the U brackets inside the Running Board. Move them to align to the main brackets. See illustration 1.

5. Place the flat and lock washers with the square head bolts. This hardware kit is included on the main brackets that are (sold separately). See illustration 1.

6. Align the Running board an tighten the bolts using a 1/2" wrench.

7. NOTE: For some regular cabs only two U brackets are needed per side.





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2. To install front, middle & rear mounting brackets locate in the rocker panel the holes covered in tape and remove the tape. Place (1) vinyl gasket to the bolt of the "T" plate then insert into the exposed hole. **SEE PICTURE** 1.

4. To install auxiliary front mounting bracket, locate existing hole next to the cab's mounting support then insert through the hole 3/8" bolt plate. Place auxiliary front mounting bracket and secure to the 3/8" bolt plate using: 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. Secure the other end to front mounting bracket using $3/8 \times 1$ " carriage head bolt, 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. Secure the other end to front mounting bracket using $3/8 \times 1$ " carriage head bolt, 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. SEE ILLUSTRATION 3. Leave loose.

NOTE 1: It is important to place vinyl gaskets to the bolts to prevent the 3/8" bolt plate from falling into the rocker panel. **SEE PICTURE 2.**

3. Place (1) front mounting bracket attach to the 3/8" bolt plate previosuly placed using: 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. Leave loose.

Use ratchet & 9/16" hex socket.

5. Place (1) middle mounting bracket attach to the 3/8" bolt plate previosuly placed using: 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. Leave loose.

6. Remove the support of the body mount, located in a flank of the frame, middle part, identify and you mount auxiliary brackets and attach with bolts before removed. Secure the other end to middle mounting bracket using 3/8 x 1" carriage head bolt, 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. **SEE ILLUSTRATION 4.** Leave loose.

Use ratchet & 19mm - 9/16" hex socket. Remove the bolt OEM with: ratchet & 19mm hex socket.

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7. Place (1) rear mounting bracket attach to the 3/8" bolt plate previosuly placed using: 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. Leave loose. 8. To install auxiliary rear mounting bracket, locate existing hole next to cab's support. **SEE PICTURE 1.** Introduce (1) 3/8" bolt plate then place rear auxiliary mounting bracket and secure to the bolt previously placed using 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. Secure the other end to the rear mounting bracket using 3/8 x 1" carriage head bolt, 3/8" flat and lock washers and 3/8" hex nut. **SEE ILLUSTRATION 5.** Leave loose. **10.** If you acquired a Oval side bar widesider 4", place on brackets and attach with: 5/16" square head bolt, 5/16" Flat and lock washer. **SEE ILLUSTRATION 7.** Repeat for the opposite side. Leave loose.

11. Align Running board widesider 5" & 6" or Oval side bar widesider 4" and then tighten all bolts.

12. Periodically check your product because it may need a re-tighten of bolts.

13. Fill the warranty card and place it inside your vehicle's glove box.

9. If you acquired a Running board widesider 5" & 6", insert 5/16" square head bolt on rail, place on brackets and attach with: 5/16" Flat and lock washer, 5/16" hex hut. **SEE ILLUSTRATION 6.** Repeat for the opposite side. Leave loose.
