



Step-1 With the vehicle brackets installed, place the passenger side OEXtreme Running Board on top of the brackets (logo to the rear). Position U-channel-brackets inside the OEXtreme Running Board body, and align the channel-brackets with the holes in the brackets, (Illustration 1). Attach the RB Running Board to each bracket using the channel-bracket, (2) M8 SEMS Bolt, (Illustration 2) and repeat steps for each other bracket.

Step-2 Align the OEXtreme Running Board then tighten all screws securing the OEXtreme Running Board and brackets. Repeat to install the driver side brackets and OEXtreme Running Board.


Instrucciones

1.- Lea y comprenda perfectamente todas las instrucciones antes de comenzar la instalación. Si alguna de las partes listadas no se encuentra, no continúe con la instalación y llame a su distribuidor inmediatamente para obtener los componentes faltantes.

2.- Para el cuidado y mantenimiento de este producto se recomienda mantenerlo limpio y no utilizar ceras abrasivas con el fin de proteger el acabado.

3.- El tiempo de instalación de este producto es de 45 min.

4. En modelos DOBLE CABINA, localice en la parte delantera y central de la carrocería del vehículo el barreno roscado y tuerca existente. VER FOTO 1. Coloque el bracket y fije de acuerdo a la ILUSTRACIÓN 1. NOTA: Coloque el espaciador como se muestra en la ilustración 1. En la parte trasera localice el barreno e inserte una tuerca clip M8. VER FOTO 2. Coloque el bracket y fije de acuerdo a la ILUSTRACIÓN 2. Repita para el lado contrario.



5. En modelos CABINA Y MEDIA, localice en la parte delantera, central y trasera de la carrocería del vehículo el barreno e inserte una tuerca clip M8. VER FOTO 2. Coloque el bracket y fije de acuerdo a la ILUSTRACIÓN 2.

Repita para el lado contrario.

6. Si adquirió Running board widesider 5" & 6", inserte el tornillo cab. cuadrada 5/16" sobre el riel, colóquelo sobre los brackets, alinee y fije con: rondanas planas y de presión 5/16", tuercas hex. 5/16". VER ILUSTRACIÓN 3. Repita para el lado contrario. No apriete aún.

7. Si adquirió Estribo ovalado widesider bar 4", colóquelo sobre los brackets y fije con: tornillo cab. cuadrada 5/16", rondanas planas y de presión 5/16". VER ILUSTRACIÓN 4. Repita para el lado contrario. No apriete aún.

8. Haga cualquier ajuste final a la alineación y apriete toda la tornillería, empezando por los brackets y después el Running board widesider 5" & 6" ó Estribo ovalado widesider bar 4".

9. Reapriete la tornillería periódicamente.

10. Llene la tarjeta de garantía y colóquela en la guantera de su vehículo.

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CREW CAB Models:

1.Locate the factory-threaded nut holes in the front and center of the vehicle's rocker panel (See Picture 1).

2. Attach the brackets according to *Illustration 1*, making sure to include the spacer as shown.

3.On the upper threaded hole, use M8 Hex bolt, M8" Flat washer, M8" Lock washer

4.On the lower welded nut, use M8 Hex bolt, M8 Flat washer, spacer, 3/8" flat washer, M8 lock washer and M8 hex nut. Refer to illustration 1

5.For the rear, locate the existing hole and insert a M8 clip nut (See *Picture 2*). Use M8 hex bolt, 5/16" lock washer, 5/16" flat washer to, on the lower use M8 hex bolt, M8" (2) flat washer, M8" lock washer and M8 hex nut. Refer to illustration 2

6.Install the rear bracket as shown in *Illustration* 1.

7.Repeat steps on the opposite side.

DOUBLE CAB Models:


1.Locate the hole at the rear of the vehicle's rocker panel (See Picture 2).

- 2.Insert an M8 clip nut.
- 3.Install the bracket following *Illustration 2*.
- 4.Repeat on the opposite side.

Note: Installation of the u-channels that are provided with this kit are referenced in the supplement sheet of the boards. Please refer to the install sheet for the boards.
