

TOOLS REQUIRED

21mm Socket Ratchet Breaker Bar Large Adjustable Wrench Joint Removal Tool Grease Gun





STEP 1

Lift and support the front of the vehicle using a floor jack and jack stands. Remove the front wheels.

Locate and loosen the front tie rod end from the steering knuckle using a 21mm socket. Once the nut is loose, use a joint removal tool to disconnect the joint from the knuckle.

Repeat this step for the opposite side of the vehicle




STEP 2

Using a large adjustable wrench, loosen the tie rod end from the vehicle center link.

Note: Additional leverage may be necessary.





STEP 3

With the tie rod end loose, completely unthread from the center link and remove from the vehicle. Adjust the new tie rod end to a similar length as the original, and install the new tie rod end to the vehicle center link and steering knuckle.

Tighten the tie rod end to the knuckle using the included lock nut to 26 ft. lbs. + 85°-100°.

Installation is now complete.
