








PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- For vehicles without factory tow hooks: Trim the plastic in the areas in Figures 1 2. Repeat for the passenger side.







- For vehicles with factory tow hooks: Remove tow hooks and loosely install Lower Mounting Brackets to factory nut plates using supplied M12 hardware as shown in Figure 4. Trim screws if they interfere with lower mounting bracket. See Figure 5.
- 4. For vehicles without tow hooks: Slip double nut plates into frame and line up with existing holes. See Figure 3. Loosely install the Lower Mounting Brackets using the supplied M12 hardware as shown in Figure 4. Trim screws if they interfere with lower mounting bracket. See Figure 5.
- 5. For 2015-2017 Models Only: Remove all factory hardware and clips attached to grille, then remove grille. See Figures 6 - 12.
































- 6. For <u>2018-2020 Models</u> Only: Remove plastic covers that are located above the location of the tow hooks to expose (3) nuts on each side. Then, remove the nuts in order to remove the front bumper. See **Figures 13 & 14** for reference.
- 7. **For all vehicle models:** Remove factory bumper bolt as shown in **Figure 15.** Install the Upper Mounting Bracket (Item 6 & 7) using the supplied M8 hardware. Make sure the brackets are approximately 39-3/4" apart from outer bracket flange. For the 2018-2020 models, make sure to lay the bracket firmly on top of the rubber strip that is on top of the bumper. Tighten M8 hardware to 15 ft-lbs. See **Figures 16 through 18.** *Note: Figure 16 for 2015-2017 models and Figure 17 for 2018-2020 models*.
- 8. Reinstall grille, headlight covers, and any other parts removed in the reverse order of the install instructions.
- 9. With assistance hold the Grille Guard up to the previously installed brackets. Loosely attach the Grille Guard to the brackets using the supplied M12 hardware. See **Figures 19 and 20.**
- 10. Align and adjust the Grille Guard as necessary. Tighten and torque M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.
















- 11. Locate and install the HDX Driver and Passenger Wings (2 and 3) using M8 hardware. See Figure 21 for reference.
- 12. Align and adjust the HDX Driver and Passenger Wings as needed. Then fully tighten all hardware at this time. Tighten and torque all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs..



13. For models with front cameras, remove the screen in the Grille Guard as shown in Figure 22.
